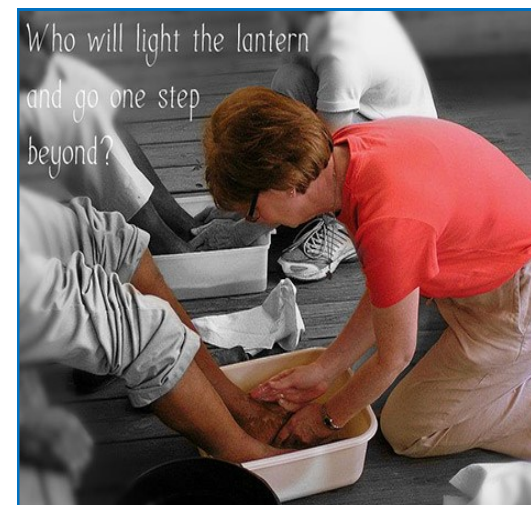

Volunteer placements include ,but are not limited to, education, health and pastoral care, direct and in-direct service with the poor in soup kitchens and shelters in the Newburgh, NY, New York City, Leominster and Fitchburg, MA areas.



Volunteers will live and pray in community with Presentation Sisters and Associates and reflect on their ministerial service in light of our Gospel values. Our long term program runs 10 months from September thru June.
